PROCEDURE

- 1. Combine ingredients 1-5 and mix well, heat to 75-80C. Then add Silica and homogenize. Cool to 40C.
- 2. Once cooled, add each of the Phase B ingredients one by one mixing well.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Combine Phase A ingredients into a vessel and heat to 80-85C.
- 2. Combine Phase B ingredients in a separate vessel and heat to 80-85C. Combine Phase B to Phase A and homogenize. Cool to 40C.
- 3. Once at 40C, add each Phase C ingredient one by one mixing well in between. Adjust pH to 5.0-6.0.

In other beauty news:

Modernization of Cosmetics Regulation Act (MoCRA) of 2022

On Dec. 29, 2022, President Biden signed into law the Consolidated Appropriations Act 2023, which includes the Modernization of Cosmetics Regulation Act (MoCRA) of 2022. MoCRA significantly changes the current regulatory framework for cosmetics in place since the enactment of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FD&C Act) in 1938.

Stated from Roley & Lardner LLP, a law firm that focuses on energy, health care and life sciences, innovative technology, and manufacturing sectors states, "Under MoCRA, cosmetic companies will be subject to facility registration and product listing requirements, good manufacturing practices (GMPs), serious adverse event reporting and recordkeeping, and safety substantiation. Furthermore, MoCRA grants the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA or Agency) the authority to order a mandatory recall of a cosmetic product and to suspend a facility registration if FDA determines there are serious adverse health concerns."
